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Honesty

*Honesty is when you speak the truth and act truthfully.

*Ways to show Honesty:

- You don't say things about people that aren't true. You are not being honest if you make up rumors about someone
- Being honest means you admit to your actions, even if you'll get in trouble. You are not being honest if deny you did something wrong when you really did it.
- You explain how a situation really happened. You are not being honest if you say something happened one way when it really happened another way.

- Focusing on Essential #9: No matter the circumstances always be honest. Even if you have done something wrong, it is best to admit it and apologize.
