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Fairness

* Fairness is not favoring anyone person above another and it allows everyone involved an equal opportunity to succeed.

* Teaching fairness to your children is important because it ensures that your children are working to treat people equally, with honesty and respect.

* Some tips to help teach fairness:

1) Set an Example

· The most important activity you can do with your children is to tell them to do as you do. Kids love to copy their parents, and this is a good way to let them do it. The trick is you must act appropriately on your own in order for it to work.

2) Post Rules

· Make a rules poster with your child. Discuss the rules that you want your child to live by regarding fairness. You can use pictures that demonstrate these qualities or spell it out with cut-out letters and glue them on a poster that your child helps to decorate. Once your poster is finished, put it on the front of the refrigerator or on their bedroom wall and go over the rules every day or so to reinforce them.

3) Role-playing

· Role-playing is a good opportunity to teach kids about fairness. Parents can really drive the point home by working together to come up with a short skit and performing it for the child.
