RESPECT

*Respect means you care enough to think about others feeling before you act.

*Respect is how you feel about someone
> Having respect for someone means you think good things about who a person is or how he/she acts. You can have respect for others, and you can have respect for yourself.

*Respect is how you treat someone
> Showing respect to someone means you act in a way that shows you care about their feelings and well-being.

*Showing respect to others might include:
> Act in a way that shows you care about their feelings and well-being.
> Not calling people mean names
> Treating people with courtesy
> Caring enough about yourself that you don't do things you know can hurt you.

*Essential #1 is to **show respect and good manners** at all times for teachers, students, and property. When responding to any adult, you must answer by saying, "Yes ma'am," "Yes sir," "No ma'am," or "No sir."
